STEPHENS COUNTY JUDGE LIFTS BURNING BAN

Stephens County Judge, Michael Roach, with the authority given to him by the Stephens County Commissioners' Court, rescinds the ban on OUTSIDE BURNING in Stephens County with the stipulation and request that anyone intending to plan and execute any type of outside burning, please contact Stephens County Fire Department (254)559-6242 to notify them of the time and location of the outside burning activity, with no fire being started if there is 15 MPH wind speed or above.

Please use extreme caution with any outside burning!

In making this announcement, the Commissioners' Court expressed its appreciation to the various firefighters, fire departments, and all other citizens of Stephens County who cooperated so diligently in helping to alleviate the emergency condition of dangerous wildfires.

It is hereby ordered by the County Judge, Michael C. Roach that the outside burning ban in Stephens County to be removed, effective immediately.
